The meeting started at 10.00 a.m. with one minute silent prayer.

The President welcomed the members of the august body to the thirty eighth meeting of the Academic Council. He thanked the members of the teaching faculty and non-teaching staff for having extended wholehearted effort in projecting the activities and achievements of Gandhigram Rural Institute – Deemed University at the time of UGC Committee visit during 7-9th January, 2010 and also NAAC visit during 16-18th April, 2010.

The President presented a brief report on the activities of the University for the period from 01.09.2009 to 22.03.2010. He stated that the Academic activities of the Institute for the last eight months were highly vibrant. To mention a few,

- 127 candidates were admitted for doing their doctoral research.
- Over 38 number of sponsored action research projects were conceived by faculty members and grant to the tune of Rs.1.48 crores was received from various funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, ICAR, CSIR, DST, UNDP, State Planning Commission, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Ministry of External Affairs, etc.
- Project proposals for a value of Rs.3.73 crores were submitted to various agencies like UGC, DST, Ministry of Water Resources, Department of Space, Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology, Tamil Nadu State Planning Commission, PCRA, DRDA, etc.
- Maintenance Grant of Rs.17.5 crores was received from the University Grants Commission to meet out the salary, VI Pay arrears to teaching, non-teaching and pensioners and expenses related to various activities of the Institute..
- The Faculties and Departments continue to conduct Village Placement Programmes.
- In order to propagate the scientific models incubated and developed by GRI, various faculty members visited different countries to participate in conferences / seminars.
- Over 46 faculty members from various faculties have participated in International and National Conferences / seminars and workshops in India.
- Over 19 training programmes / conferences and seminars were organized on various aspects of languages, rural related sciences, rural oriented social sciences, integrated rural development, sanitation, etc.
- Over 8 number of books and a large number of scientific papers were published by the faculty members during the last 8 months.

- A Special Book Gallery has been established displaying over 120 books published by GRI
  academicians in G.R. Library to benefit the large cross section of the academics,
  researchers and the students.
- 27<sup>th</sup> Convocation of the Institute was held on 22.12.2009 and 900 candidates were awarded Certificates / Diplomas / Degrees including M.Phil. and Ph.D.
- The UGC Review Committee comprising 7 eminent academicians from different parts of the country visited GRI during 7-9 January 2010 to have an on the spot assessment of activities, functions and achievements of GRI and UGC Review Committee has given an appreciative report on the overall functioning of the Institute.
- The 7 member NAAC Peer Team visited GRI during 16-18 April 2010 and assessed the performance of GRI in various spheres of the academic, research and extension including the healthy practices to reaccredit the Institute.
- In order to propagate the research findings of GRI academicians, a novel concept of organizing Popular Lecture Series ('PLS') has been evolved and is being conducted successfully every month in various colleges in different parts of Dindigul and adjacent parts and also in GRI.
- A special cell namely "Sponsored Project and Action Research Cell" (SPARC) has been created to co-ordinate all the projects.
- Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been established in GRI for quality assurance.
- GRI has brought out a special publication entitled "The Gandhigram Rural Institute –
  Deemed University its contributions to Rural India ... (1976 2010)" bringing out 35
  years of its achievements by enumerating the holistic achievements of the Institute and the
  individual contributions of the faculty members.
- The abstracts of all 296 Ph.Ds. have been brought out as a publication.
- A Booklet on 104 books authored by GRI academicians has been brought out.
- Dr.P.Anandakumar, Associate Professor of Tamil won Sahitya Akademy Award for translation
- The Vice-Chancellor has been nominated as member in Steering Committee of National Natural Resources Management System (NRDMS Programme), Government of India by the Department of Science and Technology for two years.
- The Vice-Chancellor has been nominated as a member in the Expert Committee on "Geo hazards" by DST, New Delhi, Govt. of India for three years.
- Many International visitors visited GRI.

#### 2. Item NO.541/2010.AC.IV

To consider the report of the Registrar on the action taken on the resolutions passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 31.08.2009.

The Academic Council considered the report of the Registrar on the action taken on the resolutions passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 31.08.2009 and resolved to

approve the same with the following remarks / inclusions / modifications on few items as follows:

#### i) <u>Item No.519/2009.AC.VIII</u>:

A letter was sent to ICAR by the Vice Chancellor and for the same ICAR has replied that it is not the approving or recognizing body for the course and ICAR further informed that only UGC is the recognizing body. However, ICAR grants accreditation to the programme after the first batch of students passed out.

#### ii) Item No.522/2009.AC.VIII:

The members pointed out that the Department / Centre for which the Board of Studies has been constituted is not mentioned. It was replied that the Board of Studies is related to Centre for Women's Studies.

The discussion further went on issue of accommodating a special subject / audit course on the laws of land for the girl students. After deliberations it was decided that the Centre for Women's Studies would conduct one day lecture series on laws of the land for women by inviting eminent scholars in the field so as to benefit girl students of Gandhigram Rural Institute.

#### iii) Item No.530/2009.AC.VIII:

The members expressed that Gandhigram Rural Institute need not give Course Equivalence Certificate to the students and it is only the duty of the Government to issue the same. After deliberations it was decided that GRI should own the responsibility of issuing the same.

Item No.530/2009.AC.VIII while discussing on the equivalence certificates for M.Sc. Applied Biology course, it was insisted by the Head, Department of Biology that the modalities followed to issue equivalence certificate for programmes namely M.Sc. Tech (Industrial Maths with Computer application) and M.Sc. Home Science Extension may be followed for M.Sc. Applied Biology programme too following the existing norms of getting it evaluated by a duly constituted committee.

With regard to the M.Phil programme offered by the Department of Applied Research in particular, and the other M.Phil programmes offered by various departments at GRI in general, it was resolved to adopt the format prescribed for Ph.D.

#### iv) <u>Item No.534/2009.AC.VIII</u>:

The members suggested that though the Fruit Processing Unit has been transferred to the Department of RIM from Rural Technology Centre, the lab and machinery used for B.Sc. Sustainable Technology should be put to optimal use and the activities in the lab need to go on as a continuous process. Dr.Seerangarajan assured that the lab and machinery shall be fully utilised for training and practical for the students and training to rural people.

#### 3. Item No.542/2010.AC.IV

To consider the report / recommendation of the committee constituted to scrutinize the syllabus and other aspects to issue equivalence certificate for M.Sc. Tech (Industrial Mathematics with Computer Applications).
