The meeting started with one minute silent prayer at 10.30 a.m.

Dr. S. Natarajan, Vice-Chancellor, Gandhigram Rural Institute and Chairperson of the Academic Council welcomed the members. He introduced and welcomed the new members, Dr.C.Thangamuthu, former Vice-Chancellor, Bharathidasan University and Dr.K.Muthuchelian, former Vice-Chancellor, Periyar University to the august body. He wished the members for a very successful academic year ahead. He thanked the members for their august presence to discuss the academic matters of the GRI. He presented the activities that took place since the previous Academic Council meeting.

- Appointment of Dr.KM.Annamalai, Chancellor of Gandhigram Rural Institute for a period of five years from 20.04.2017.
- First GRI Society meeting held on 29.05.2017 in New Delhi in the presence of the Hon'ble Minister of Human Resource Development as Chairperson.

- Rank 91 out of 100 in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF). It is a milestone as GRI has registered for the first time and has achieved this from among 740 Universities.
- GRI website ranking of 71
- Streamlining the Ph.D. admission as January session for part-time candidates and August session for full-time candidates.
- Admission of 1334 students for the academic year 2017-18.
- Digitization of all activities of the Institute, including admission of students through single window system, salary to staff members, etc.
- Orientation programme to faculty members on National Digital Library

Dr.Anandhavalli Mahadevan, on behalf of the members of the Academic Council, welcomed the new Chancellor of Gandhigram Rural Institute, Dr.KM.Annamalai and wished him all success. She informed that the Gandhigram Rural Institute has showed its growth and development in all the phases like digitization of admission process, collection of fees, admission demand ratio at the rate of 1 : 24, additions to infrastructure and she congratulated the Vice-Chancellor and all the staff members for this stupendous growth.

#### 2. <u>Item No.819/2017/AC.VI</u>:

To consider and approve the report of the Registrar on the action taken on the resolutions passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 08.03.2017.

The Vice-Chancellor informed the august body that University Grants Commission has given extension to Centre for Women's Studies only up to 30.09.2017 and hence introduction of new Programmes by the Centre for Women's Studies could not be considered. (Item No. 794/2017/AC.III.

The Academic Council considered and resolved to approve the report of the Registrar on the action taken on the resolution passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 08.03.2017.

#### 3. Item No.820/2017/AC.VI:

To consider and approve the minutes of the meeting of Research Advisory Committee held on 05.05.2017.

Dr. S.Ramaswamy, Director (Research and Development) presented the minutes of the meeting of the Research Advisory Committee held on 05.05.2017 and it was seconded by Dr.N.D.Mani, Professor and Dean, Faculty of Rural Development.

It was pointed out that the candidates are admitted to Ph.D. after going through the process of written examination and interview along with common presentation in the presence of senior academicians, etc. and admissions are being carried out as per UGC norms.

The members felt the need to improve the quality of research by the scholars and appreciated the decision of the Research Advisory Committee in making the Course Work compulsory for Ph.D. candidates from the academic year 2017-18.

The members appreciated the decision (of the RAC) that the registration of a candidate to Ph.D. will be confirmed only after the successful completion of course work examinations within the stipulated time limit.

The Chairperson requested the Deans and Heads of Departments to discuss at Faculty level / Department level on the coursework examination, the procedure to be followed in setting of question papers, assessment / evaluation, etc. The decision taken in the meeting of the Faculty/ Department shall be discussed in the Deans / Heads of Department meeting and later be placed in the RAC. The decision of the RAC may be placed in the next meeting of the Academic Council which is likely to be conducted in the 4<sup>th</sup> week of August, 2017.

It was felt that the exit option in the module will tempt the students to opt out of the Programme at the end of three years with a bachelor degree and he will suffer in the society without having any knowledge of Sociology because in integrated programmes the syllabus are framed in such a way that they will not be familiar either with the major papers of Sociology or the elective papers at the end of three years. The members insisted that piece-meal like syllabus will not be effective in integrated programmes and the students will not be able to compete with the students of regular U.G. Sociology students of other colleges. This is due to the fact that 5 year Programme is a very rigorous one and integration of the subjects (Courses) is very important.

It was pointed out that all the Programmes should have a Course on Environmental Studies and the syllabus of M.A. (5 year Integrated) Sociology will be framed in such a way to include Environmental Studies as per the UGC norms.

The Academic Council, after detailed discussion, resolved that the M.A. (5 year integrated) Sociology programme (without exit option) will be offered in lieu of M.A.Sociology from the academic year 2017-18.
