10. Item No.869/2018/AC.III:

To consider the recommendations of the 7th Planning and Monitoring Board held on 16.03.2018 for consideration from the academic year 2018-19.

The Academic Council considered and resolved the following:

- 1. Conducting of short-term courses at the level of Certificate and Diploma, benefiting rural mass, from next academic year.
- 2. Revision of syllabus for the existing and new academic programmes by the academic units incorporating at least 20% of MOOC courses as envisaged by MHRD.
- 3. Programmes for skilling of workers in textile sector in collaboration with NIFT, Tirupur can be planned and implemented.
- 4. Except the regular academic programmes, all innovative courses and existing and new Certificate / Diploma / B.Voc. courses should be offered on self supporting mode only.
- 5. Students' admission strength for each programme shall be fixed by each academic unit and 100% achievement shall be made.
- 6. The Registrar will issue a Circular informing that the Aadhaar Card and Blood group details may be obtained from all the students who are to be admitted from the ensuing academic year and for the recruitment of staff in the Institute.
- The Registrar will issue a Circular to all Deans/HoDs/Directors/Coordinators regarding wearing of ID
 card by the students within the campus and also circular for the issue of No Due Certificate for issuing
 Transfer Certificate.
- 8. From the Academic Year 2018-19, online registration linked with tuition fees shall be implemented. Students may be informed suitably of this arrangement.

11. Item No.870/2018/AC.III - ANY OTHER MATTER:

The Chairperson presented the following and the Academic Council approved the same.

- 1. After the approval of academic programmes in Academic Council the draft syllabus prepared by the academic units can be presented and finalized at School level meet before BoS is convened on 23.05.2018. The soft copy of the academic programmes approved in each BoS can be sent to the Academic Committee for scrutiny and for further presentation in AC to be held on 13th June, 2018.
- 2. Deans / Heads of Departments / Directors shall update the list of external examiners for all the courses and panel of members of selection committee for teaching posts.
